

STOWMARKET VOLLEYBALL CLUB

TITLE

The club shall be called
"Stowmarket Volleyball Club"

PURPOSE

To promote and encourage the game of volleyball in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the English Volleyball Association.

MANAGEMENT

The affairs of the club shall be conducted by a committee consisting of a chairman, secretary and treasurer. The committee shall meet and act as required for the efficient conduct of the club with powers to co-opt additional members if required.

A quorum shall consist of not less than half the total strength of the committee.

The officers of the committee will be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting, should any vacancy occur, the committee has the power to fill the post until the next Annual General Meeting.

The committee shall have power to constitute sub-committee as may be deemed necessary.

No person can be proposed for election to the committee in their absence unless written evidence of their desire to stand is presented at the time of election.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the club will be open to all persons upon payment of the appropriate subscription to be determined at the A.G.M. The club reserve the right to refuse membership to any person who the majority of paid up members do not accept.

FINANCE

The financial year of the club shall run from the 1st April to the 31st March each year. The accounts of the club will be balanced at 31st March each year and submitted after independent audit to the Annual General Meeting that follows the audit.

The main funds of the club are to be held in a Bank. All orders are to be signed by any two of Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. At the Annual General Meeting and at other times upon reasonable if so requested, the Treasurer will produce a statement of income and expenditure.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The club shall hold an Annual General Meeting in April every year. An extraordinary General Meeting may be called by the committee or an application in writing to the secretary by any three paid up members. Each member present at the meeting is entitled to one vote.

NOTICES

Any amendment to the constitution shall be proposed in writing to the secretary at least one calendar month before Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary Meeting.

NOTICES CONT...

The agenda of the Annual General Meeting and of any Extraordinary General Meeting shall be sent to all members not less than fourteen days before the meeting.

ALTERATIONS

Alterations to the constitution require a two-thirds majority of members at the Annual General Meeting or at any Extraordinary General Meeting that may be called.

GENERAL

In the event of any matters arising which are not provided for in the constitution such matters shall be dealt with by the committee, whose decision shall be final.

If Stowmarket Volleyball Club dissolves all assets shall be passed to the county association in trust. If no county association exists they are to be conveyed to the English Volleyball Association.
